# Motivation for **RIPEstat**

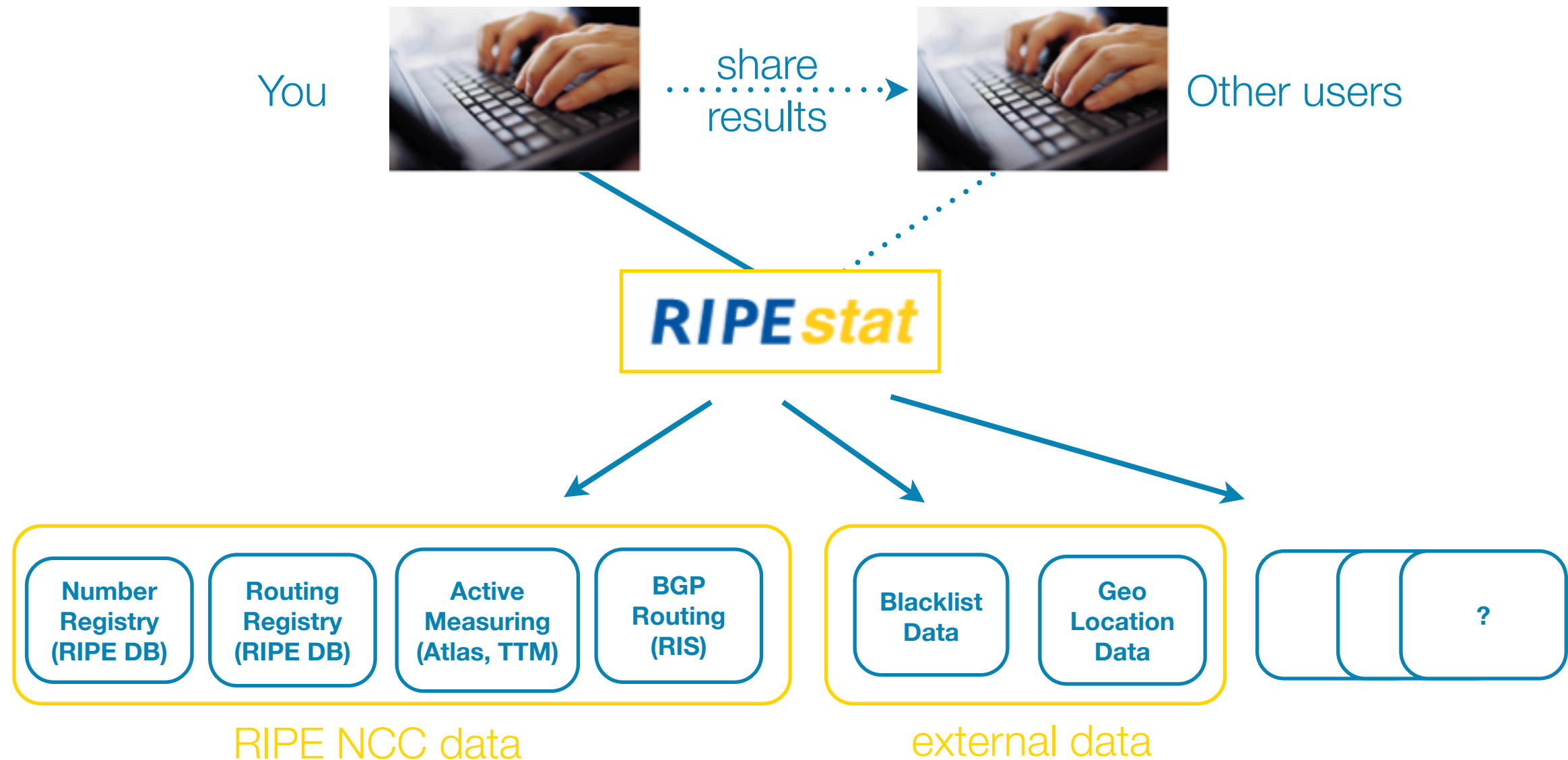

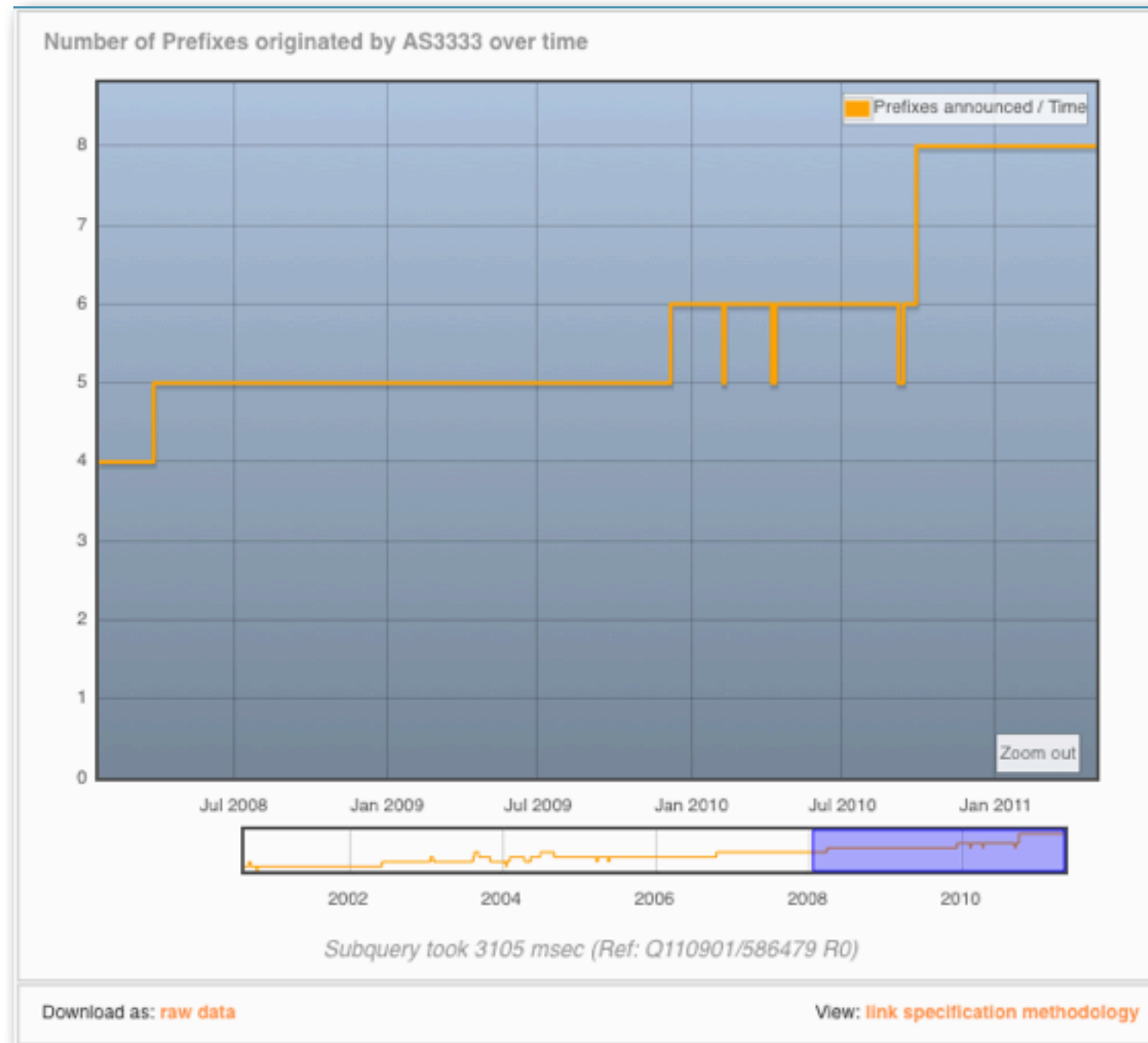

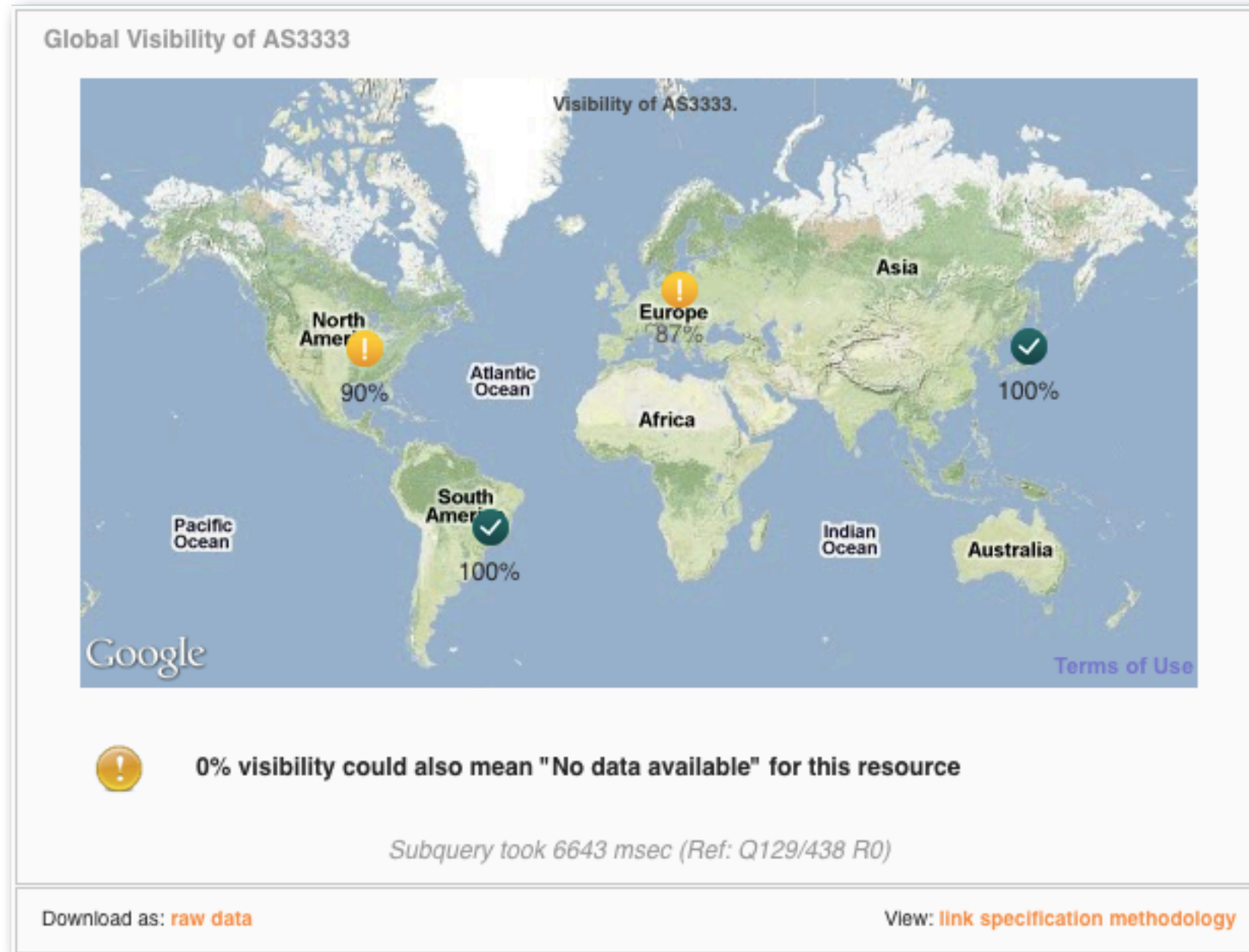

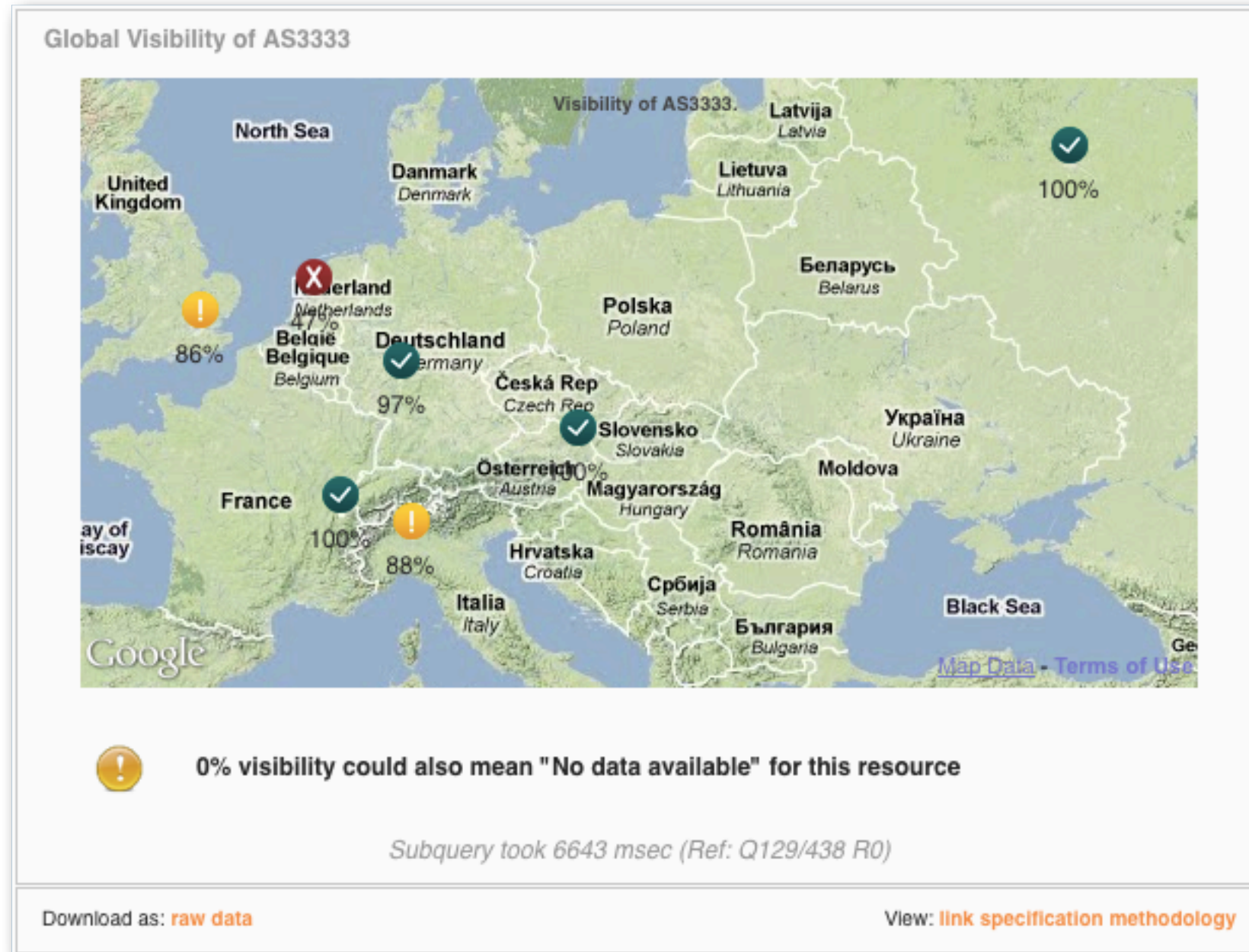

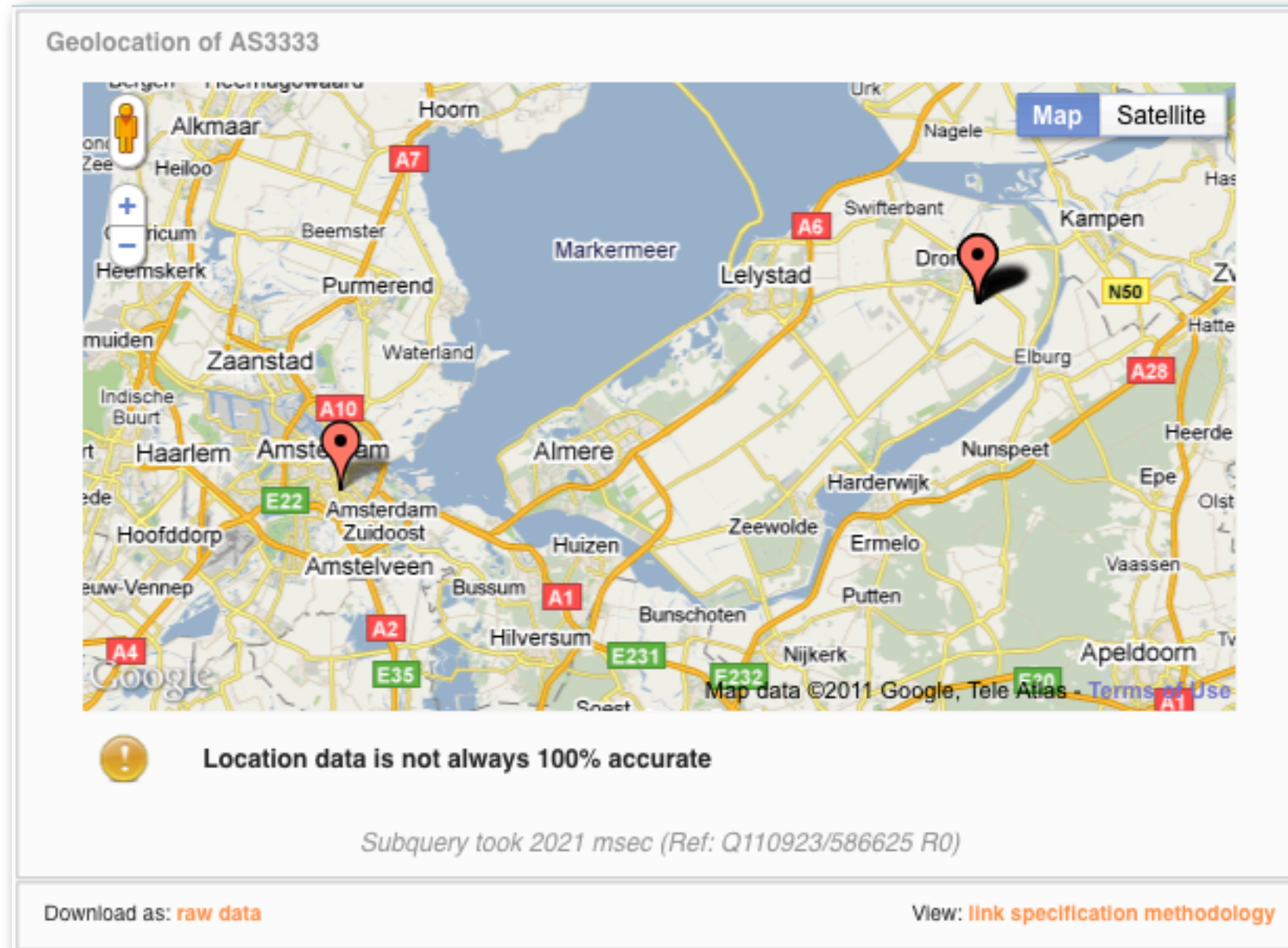
